This session will provide Speech Pathologists, Teachers, Clinicians and others with strategies that can be implemented immediately in their classrooms and therapy settings. Participants will put on “OT colored glasses” to view their own lessons using OT theories and strategies. They will look at the student, environment setup, and the activity. They will review foundation skills/systems required for academic success (The Central Nervous System, Sensory Systems, Sensorimotor Development, and Perceptual Development) and learn strategies to address areas of need. Environmental modifications will be discussed, including how the placement of materials may impact performance for some students and how to make small changes for success. A step-by-step activity analysis will be done using the OT Practice Framework. A packet of simple strategies and a glossary of OT term will be provided.

Learner Objectives - *As a result of this activity, participant will be able to:*

- identify strategies to help their students increase foundation skills required for academic success
- identify strategies for setting up activities to either increase or decrease the demands of the task
- explain “activity analysis”
- define OT terms including sensory integration, bilateral coordination, reflex integration
